1. Scope of Work

4. Photographer's Rights & Usage

- Photographer retains full copyright of all images captured.
- Client receives a personal, non-commercial license to use, print, and share the images.
- Client may not sell, alter, or submit photos to contests or publications without Photographer's prior written consent.
- Photographer reserves the right to use images from the wedding for portfolio, website, social media, and other promotional purposes, unless Client requests otherwise in writing prior to the Wedding Date.

5. Client Responsibilities

- Client shall provide a full and accurate wedding day timeline to the Photographer at least 2 weeks before the event.
- Client shall ensure the cooperation of the wedding party, family members, and guests, and inform them of the photography schedule (including group/family photo lists).
- Client is responsible for confirming and securing any permissions required from venues for photography, including any venue photography fees.
- Client shall provide the Photographer with a meal during the reception where coverage exceeds 6 hours, and reasonable rest breaks.
- Client is responsible for ensuring that the parents or legal guardians of any children present at the wedding (other than the Client's own children, where applicable) have given permission for those children to be photographed and for such images to be used in accordance with Section 4 (Photographer's Rights & Usage).

6. Cancellation & Rescheduling

- If Client cancels the wedding, the retainer/deposit is non-refundable.
- If cancellation occurs within 30 days of the Wedding Date, Client is responsible for 30% of the total fee.
- If the wedding is postponed, the Photographer will transfer the booking to the new date where available, subject to the Photographer's availability.
- If Photographer is unable to attend due to reasons within their control, Client will receive a full refund of all payments made, and Photographer will use reasonable efforts to assist in securing a replacement photographer.

7. Liability

- Photographer is not responsible for circumstances beyond their control, including but not limited to: weather, venue restrictions, lateness of the wedding party or guests, or interference by guests or other vendors.
- In the unlikely event of equipment failure, illness, or emergency preventing the Photographer from attending, the Photographer will make reasonable efforts to arrange a suitably qualified replacement photographer of similar style, or refund monies paid for coverage not delivered.
- Photographer is not liable for incidental or consequential damages, and total liability shall not exceed the total fee paid under this Agreement.

8. Force Majeure

Neither party shall be held liable for failure to perform due to events beyond reasonable control (e.g., natural disasters, illness, government restrictions, transport strikes, or venue closures).

9. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.

10. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between Photographer and Client and supersedes all prior discussions or agreements, written or oral, relating to the Wedding Date.
